

# **OVERVIEW**

### What is it?


A **case competition** in which contenders develop and submit a business proposal for a **tech idea**, **device or service** that supports a social justice or a humanitarian cause in the areas of **gender and human rights**.

# **PROCESS**

- **1. Prepare**: attend a 1-hr overview session in which you will review market research, SWOT analysis, minimum viable product design, and business case prep training.
- **2. Develop**: take three (3) months to work on your own original proposal for a viable tech idea, product or service that will serve humanity.
- **3. Submit** 5-10 slides with concept, SWOT, and business plan.
- **4. Present** your idea at a group meeting with other submitters, HerRights, and guest judge(s).





### MORE

- All proposals will be published and publicized by HerRights and its partners via web and social media channels.
- All contestants will receive consultation and as applicable, referrals to corporate support, internship opportunities, and recruitment pipelines.
- ☐ The top submission (decided by peer voting + guest judge ranking) will win \$200 dollars.
- ☐ All submitters will receive a letter of recommendation and a participation certificate from HerRights.
- ☐ Submitters retain full rights over their proposals
- Submitters will receive mentoring as needed if they choose to pitch their idea elsewhere (e.g., Shark Tank or other corporate, investment, or university incubation programs).
